## We should follow God with a sense of urgency.

"Don't be misled—you cannot mock the justice of God. You will always harvest what you plant. <sup>8</sup>Those who live only to satisfy their own sinful nature will harvest decay and death from that sinful nature. But those who live to please the Spirit will harvest everlasting life from the Spirit. <sup>9</sup>So let's not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don't give up. <sup>10</sup>Therefore, whenever we have the opportunity, we should do good to everyone—especially to those in the family of faith." (Galatians 6:7-10 NLT)

## We should share the Gospel with a sense of urgency.

"I solemnly urge you in the presence of God and Christ Jesus, who will someday judge the living and the dead when he comes to set up his Kingdom: Preach the word of God. Be prepared, whether the time is favorable or not. Patiently correct, rebuke, and encourage your people with good teaching." (2 Timothy 4:1-2 NLT)

## We should live with a sense of urgency so our, "If I would have known" becomes "I'm glad that I did."

"So be careful how you live. Don't live like fools, but like those who are wise. <sup>16</sup>Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days. <sup>17</sup>Don't act thoughtlessly, but understand what the Lord wants you to do." (Ephesians 5:15-17 NLT)
