Middle School Discussion Guide

Generous Generation: For the week of February 27 - March 5, 2022

Main Thought & Scriptures:

Giving money or gifts are common ways people practice generosity, but those aren't the only methods. Stewardship (definition: the job of supervising or taking care of something) of money is one way to honor God and bless others. How we spend our money can say a lot about us as a person. Now think about different ways of "spending." For example, our time. Time consists of seconds, minutes, hours, days, weeks, months, and so on. If we can spend our time in a healthy way, we will express a generosity that honors God and blesses others. Therefore, Christ-like generosity is the giving away of what we have with an understanding that what we have was given to us by God, to bless others.

- Talk as a group and share different ways we can be generous.
- Share a time that someone was generous to you.

God gives us an opportunity to practice being generous to Him.
